Applications are invited for the post of one Junior Research Fellow (JRF) under Indo-Russian Joint project entitled "Mesoproterozoic microbiotas of Eurasia: an integrated approach to the Indian and Russian early eukaryote-dominated assemblages" tenable at the Birbal Sahni Institute of Palaeosciences under the supervision of Dr. Mukund Sharma, Scientist 'F' and Principal Investigator of the DST-RFBR supported Project.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATION, EXPERIENCE AND AGE LIMIT:**

**Junior Research Fellow - 01**

Essential Qualification: Post Graduation in Geology/Botany from any recognized university with minimum 60% marks at graduation and post-graduation level.

Desirable qualifications: Demonstrable experience in processing and study of Precambrian microfossils and ability to compute data on modern softwares. Project work involves geological field work. Preference may be given to CSIR/UGC NET/GATE qualified candidate.

Fellowship: Rs. 25,000/- + 20% HRA per month.

Age limit: 28 years as on 20.4.2018

1. The tenure of Junior Research Fellowship is for two years or co-terminus with the project whichever is earlier.
2. Only Indian citizens normally residing in India are eligible to apply for the above position.
3. The award of Junior Research Fellowship shall not imply any assurance or guarantee for subsequent employment at the Birbal Sahni Institute of Palaeosciences, Lucknow or Department of Science & Technology, New Delhi.
4. Medical benefits may be allowed as per the Staff Rules of the Institute.
5. No Research Fellow will be allowed to discontinue his/her fellowship without the prior approval of the Institute.
6. Age relaxation: In the case of applicants of Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other backward Classes, age relaxation up to FIVE years may be allowed. For PH candidates/Woman candidates the age relaxation will be applicable as per Government of India Rules.
