
Birbal Sahni Institute of Palaeosciences Monthly Summaryof Research Activities (March 2024)

1. Areas of Focus:

The institute carries out research on fundamental as well as applied aspects of Palaeosciences that includes Evolutionary history of biota, Paleoclimate, studies of past civilization, Human history and contemporary Climate Change issues, following an integrated and multi-disciplinary approach.

- a. Key Scientific Findings of the Month (March 2024)
- In general perspective, the oceanic circulation conveyor belt is slowing down, which could be a reason for the warming on both the poles (Antarctica and the Arctic). The present study also reported that in the past 65,000 to 60,000 years, the oceanic circulation (AMOC) was slowed down, and the impact on the Arabian Sea also influenced the Indian Ocean monsoon system. Hence, our study documented the warming signal in the cold period around 65,000 to 60,000 years (Khan et al., 2024).
